- The **D. Scott Hudgens Center for Skilled Nursing**, the only one of its kind in the southeastern U.S.
- Two **day programs**, including private pay and community access waiver funded options
- A community-based independent living program called **All In**, enabling adults to live in the apartment or home of their choosing
